

Don Drake Memorial Scholarship for 2011 Awarded Posthumously to Larry Schroeder

KA9KDC, Larry Schroeder, Silent Key, was named the Don Drake Award recipient for the current year at the November WCRA meeting for his outstanding public service to the Ham Community in maintaining and acting as host for the Club's W9CCU Repeater. The award was announced to the Club by John Faber , WT9Y, the 2010 Award winner. (See Photo)

Don Drake's widow, Dorothy, established the Fund with a private donation and also gave the Club Don's ham equipment. Some items were used to equip the Communications Support Unit, but most equipment was sold at auctions or at the Hamfest to supplement the Scholarship donation amount. This extended the years of the Scholarship to eight and the amount to \$300.

The Club Repeater is still at the Schroeder residence, but Larry's wife, Carol, KB9FYL, says "there is no rush" to find a new home for it. Plans are underway to relocate the equipment and antenna on a new site. Ever since the WDCB tower crashed, the Schroeder family has had the repeater as a "roomer" at their home.
